



CODE OF CONDUCT

PLAYER CODE OF CONDUCT

- Absolutely no fighting or Striking by a player or a player's official, this is considered an assault and NOOBA will prosecute any offender. The assaulted player does not have to bring charges on the player, the National One-on-One Basketball Association will. You will be expelled for 5 years from all NOOBA Tournaments
- Absolutely no taunting or trash talking and anytime during a match
- A dispute can go no longer than 30 seconds after which a technical foul will be assessed to the offending player by the umpire for delay of game, that player also loses possession of ball. On the 2nd technical foul the game is forfeited, on the third technical foul the match is forfeited.
- No Unnecessary Roughness by players is allowed in matches and can lead to a technical foul or forfeit of match.
- A Player cannot verbally speak with a coach or manager during a game and can only verbally communicate during in warm-ups or between games - penalty is a technical foul
- Players must ensure that anybody accompanying you also behaves in a sportsmanlike manner
- PLAYING UNDER THE INFLUENCE OF ALCOHOL AND DRUGS IS STRICTLY PROHIBITED
- The smell or visual evidence is all that is required. You will be expelled from participating in a NOOBA tournament for 2 years
- SHAKE HANDS AND THANK YOUR OPPONENT AND UMPIRE AFTER THE MATCH.

COACHES AND MANAGERS CODE OF CONDUCT

- No fighting at anytime
- Coaches and managers must sit in their player's corner and can do no coaching while the game is in progress and can only verbally coach in warm-ups or between games - penalty is a technical foul.
- No profanity is allowed at anytime during the tournament, penalty is a technical foul on your player.
- Coach or Manager can question an umpire or referees but once the decision is made it is a dead issue

SPECTATOR CODE OF CONDUCT

- No fighting
- As a courtesy to players, spectators in seated area must remain seated during a Play Phase
- No profanity is allowed at anytime within the venue
- No littering
- Supporters must not disrupt play, threaten abuse or assault anybody at the tournament, violators will be expelled from tournament.
